description: Map showing Nuremberg's historical city centre and surrounding area, with indications of the extent of damage after the end of the war. Mapped area mostly limited to the city centre within the historical city walls.

basemap: *title*: Base Map of City Centre, June 1942

description: Map showing Nuremberg's historical city centre and the surrounding area on a scale of 1:5,000. Date June 1942 (lower right corner) faded and thus hard to read, but confirmed with derived maps with identical base map and clear date. The base map of 1942 was reprinted multiple times. The scan present in this entry is of an unchanged reissue of 1944. The date "1944" is noted in a legend box in the bottom-left corner of the map.

Yellow: completely destroyed.

Brown: heavily damaged.

Light brown: light to medium damage.

Green: intact.

Yellow/red frame: burned out, outer wall parts slightly damaged.

Yellow/black frame: burned out, outer wall parts heavily damaged.

Yellow/brown frame: wall parts at risk of collapsing.

Brown/red frame: severely damaged with well-preserved outer wall parts.

Numbers: Indication of the presence of more or less damaged artistic/architectural Elements and figures.

Yellow, crossed out in red (light) and black (heavy): still existing but damaged, partially inhabited

basements, underpasses, and bridges.
